In accordance with A Culture of Honesty, the university's academic honesty policy and procedures, we are providing the University Council with the attached report for the 2024-2025 academic year. Semester reports are on our [website](#). We are also pleased to report on the following highlights from our office:

- Piloted an import of Academic Integrity Modules content into First-Year Odyssey (FYO) Seminar Program courses in Fall 2024
- Partnered with University Libraries tabling at FACTS Fairs for UGA Libraries in August 2024
- Student Ambassadors engaged students in tabling at Tate Plaza in February 2025 regarding academic integrity issues at UGA
- Staff attended International Center for Academic Integrity (ICAI) annual conference in March 2025; Alexander Conetta, an Office of Academic Honesty Experiential Learning student and Peer Learning Assistant in the Office of Student Success attended thanks to a grant from the Parents Leadership Council; and Shinhee Park, graduate research assistant, presented a poster titled "Fostering Inclusion in Restorative Justice: Enhancing Psychological Safety for Students and Faculty."
- Hosted free coffee stations for students on the first day of finals in fall and spring semesters

In addition to administering the university's academic honesty policy and speaking to numerous groups of students, faculty and teaching assistants, we continue to make every effort to resolve faculty concerns about possible cases of academic dishonesty quickly and fairly. We appreciate the assistance provided by our faculty and professional staff who assist in facilitating academic honesty discussions, the service of faculty and students who volunteer to serve as panel members and as remediation representatives, and to those who support and promote academic integrity at UGA by reporting concerns, requesting speakers, and seeking guidance about issues of possible academic misconduct.




Overview


