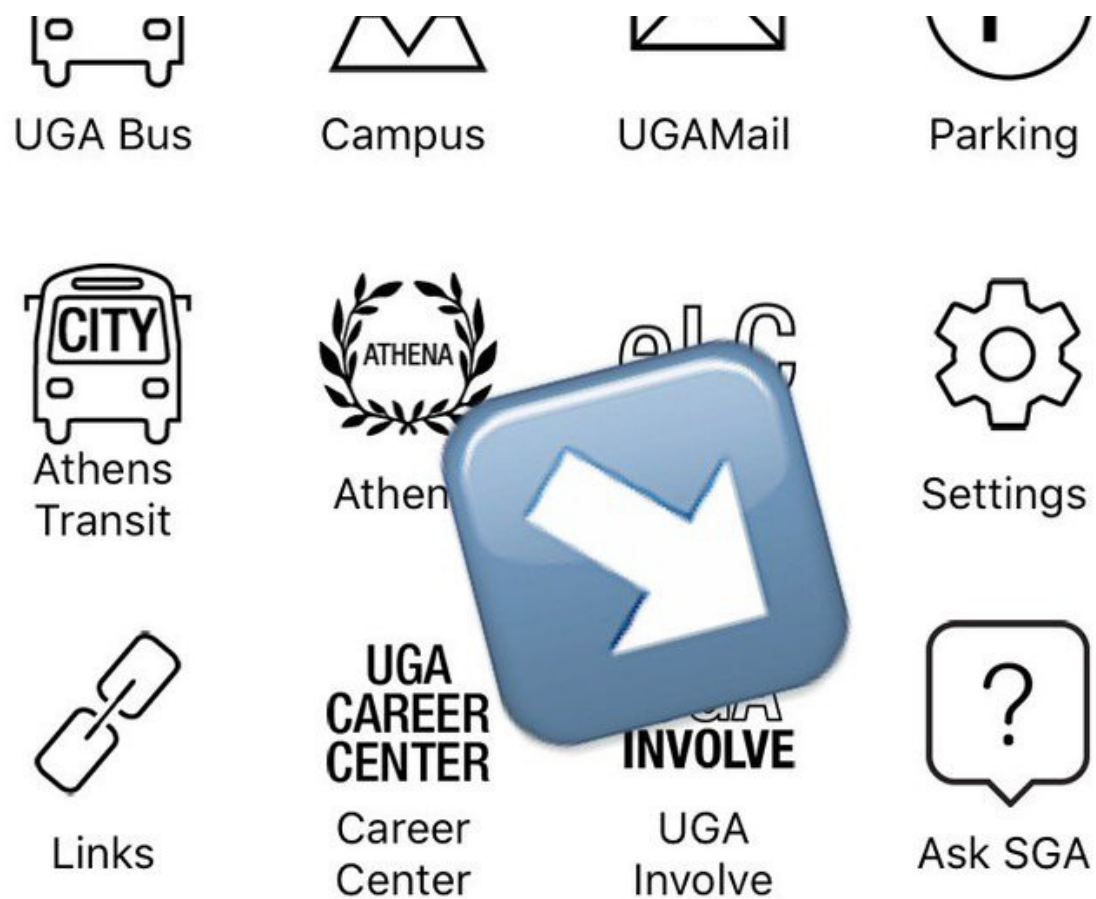


WHAT IS SGA ?

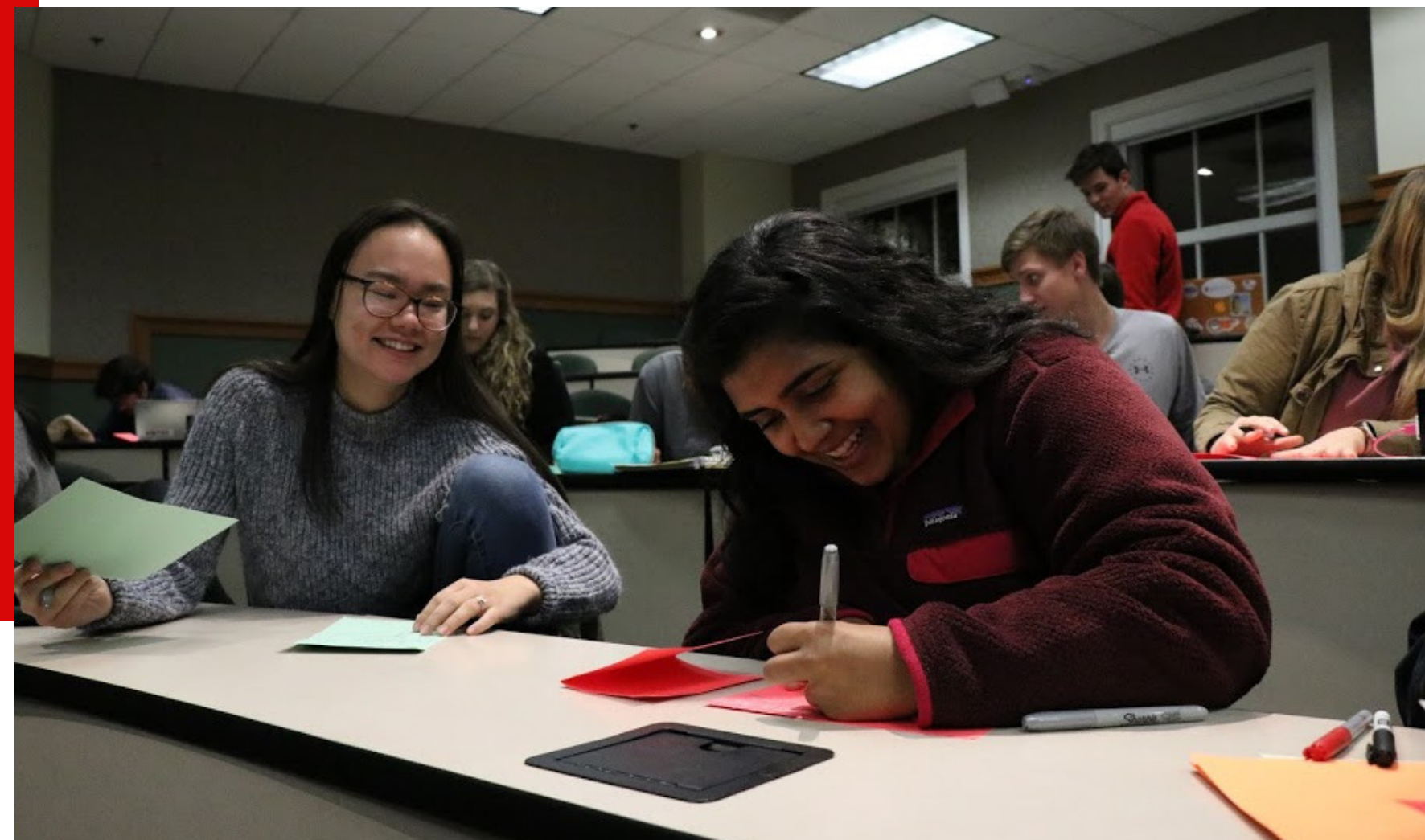

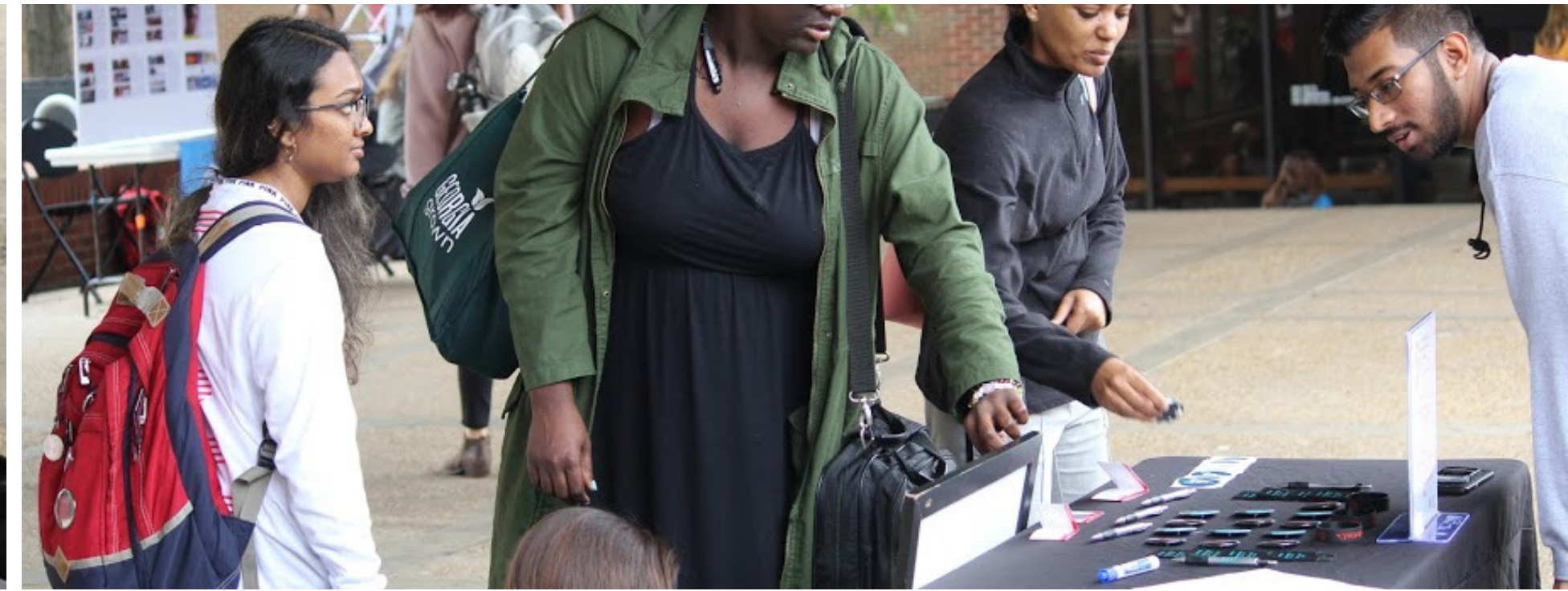
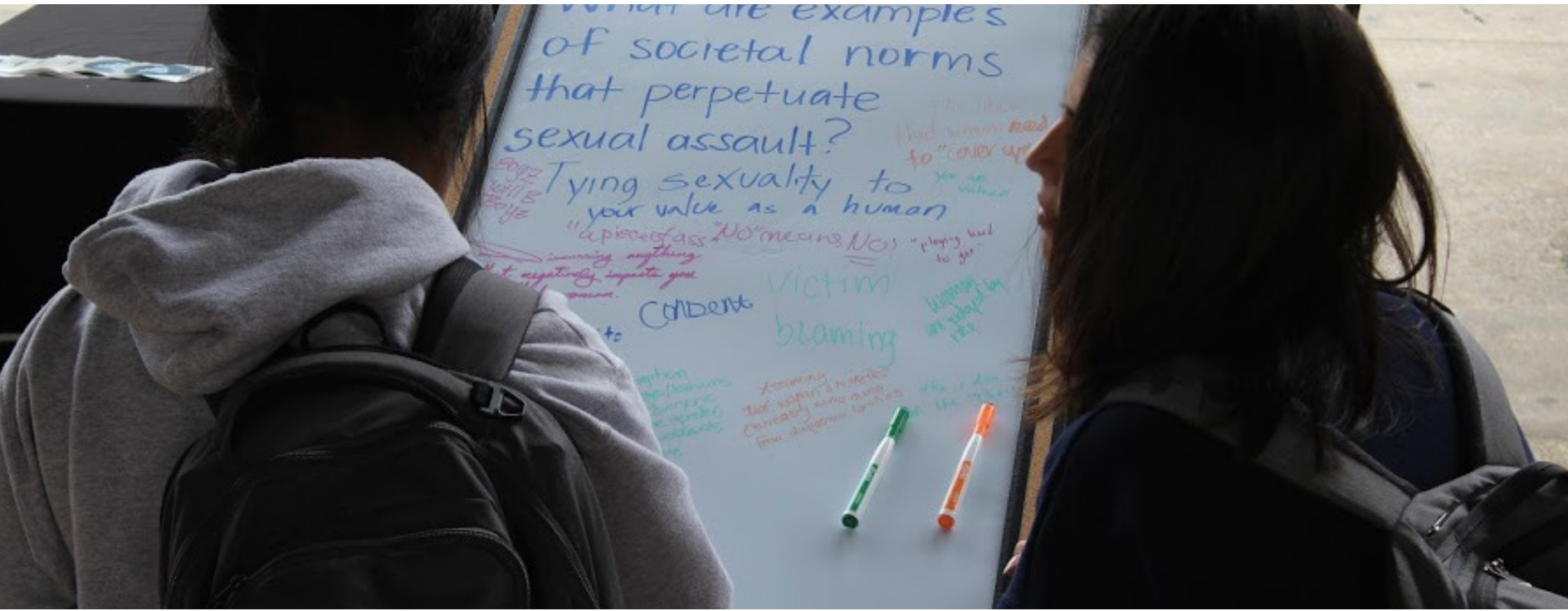


LISTENING NIGHTS

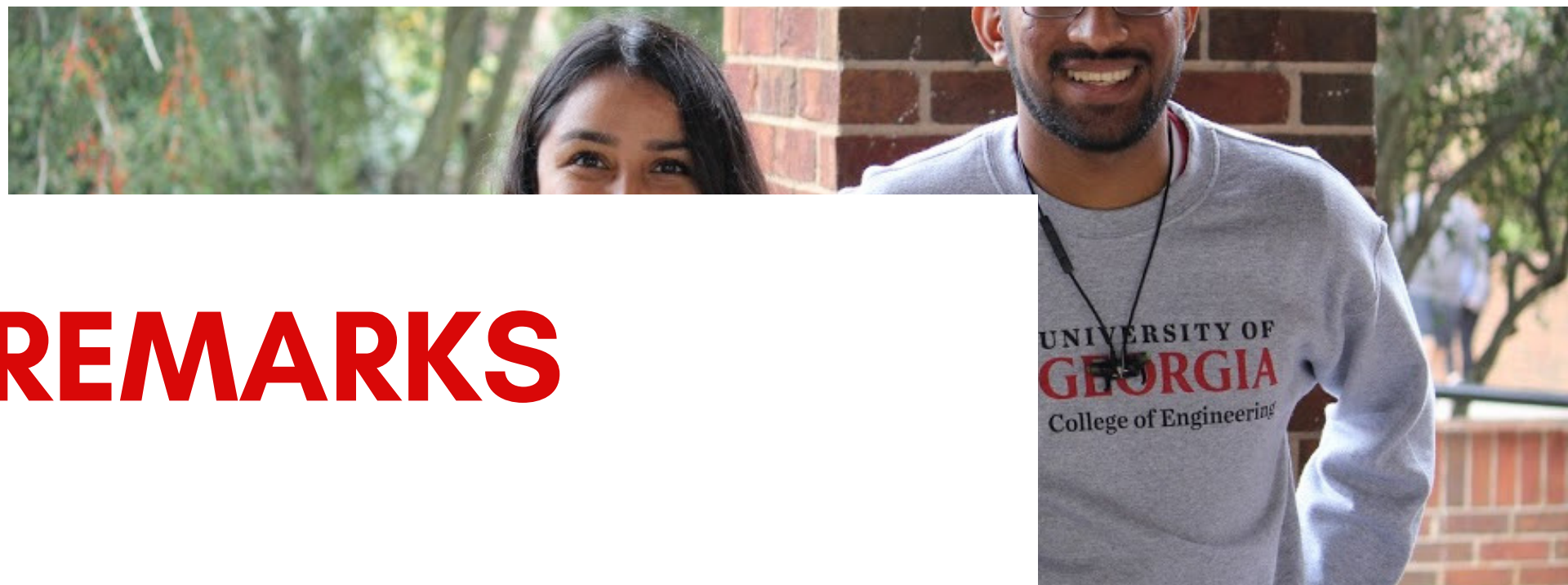
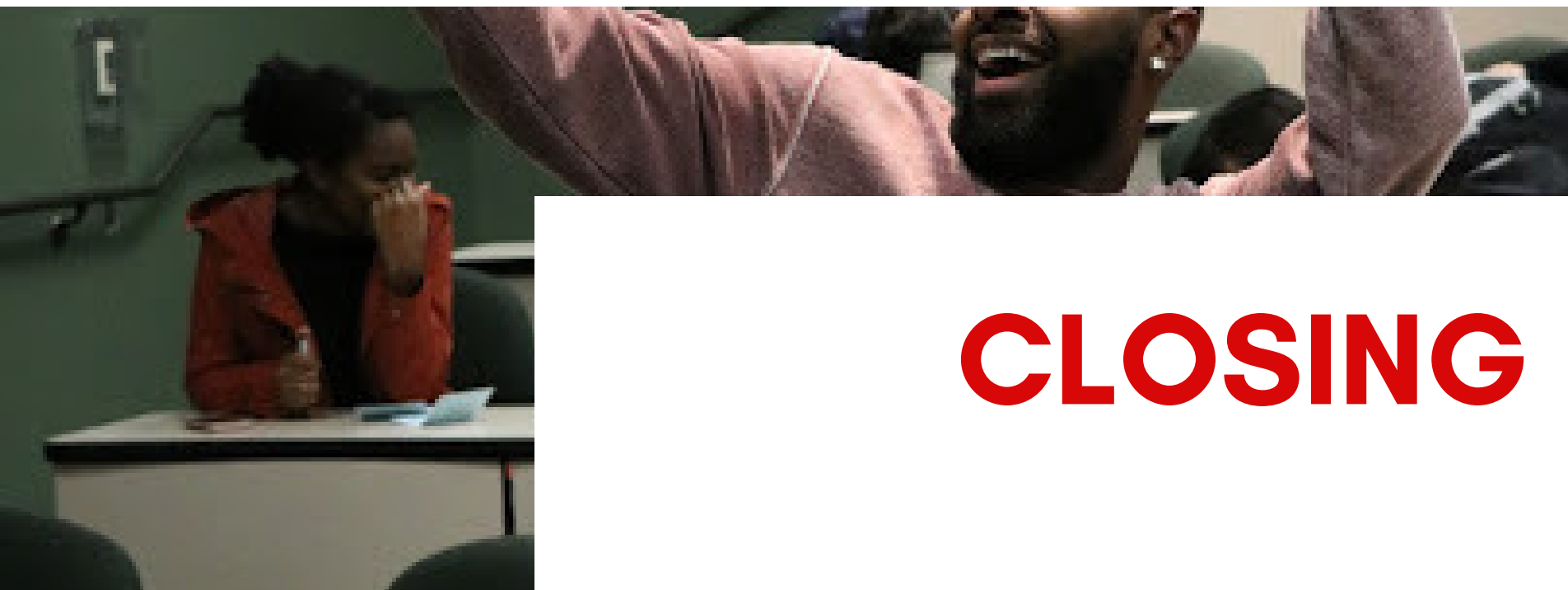
