Proposal to Revise the Bylaws for the Faculty/Staff Parking Appeals Committee

Proposal: To revise the bylaws of the Faculty/Staff Parking Appeals Committee.

Rationale: The Faculty/Staff Parking Appeals Committee recommended to the Statutes and Bylaws Committee the revision of the "Administration" portion of its bylaws. In considering the committee's request, the Statutes and Bylaws Committee recommended to the Faculty/Staff Parking Appeals Committee that the remainder of its bylaws on "Membership" be revised to align with those of other University Council standing committees so that (1) faculty are elected and not appointed to the committee and (2) faculty and staff members serve three-year instead of two-year terms. The Faculty/Staff Parking Appeals Committee voted to accept the revisions proposed by the Statutes and Bylaws Committee.

Revision:

A. Membership

Faculty: Two voting members of the Faculty/Staff Parking Appeals Committee shall be appointed by the University Council Executive Committee. Faculty may be appointed from within or outside the University Council and shall serve two year terms, beginning in the month of September. Two voting faculty members shall be elected from among the faculty members of the University Council to serve for three-year terms even if their membership on University Council expires prior to their term of service on this committee.

Staff: Two voting staff members, elected by the Staff Council, shall serve as voting members of the Faculty/Staff Parking Appeals Committee. The staff members of the Faculty/Staff Parking Appeals Committee shall serve two-year three-year terms beginning in the month of August even if their membership on the Staff Council expires prior to their term of service on this committee.

Administration: : One representative from Parking Services shall serve as a non-voting member of the Faculty/Staff Parking Appeals Committee. One ex-officio, non-voting Parking Services employee representative shall be appointed to the committee by the Auxiliary Service Director of Transportation and Parking Services and shall serve for a one-year term.

Faculty/Staff Parking Appeals Committee Chair: The Chair of the Faculty/Staff Parking Appeals Committee shall be elected each year from among the faculty and staff members on the Committee by those with voting privileges.

B. Duties

To consider all appeals from faculty and staff concerning parking tickets and fines
at The University of Georgia. Tie votes by the committee shall be regarded as a
denial of appeal. The President of the University has delegated authority to this
committee to make final institutional decisions on faculty and staff traffic and
parking appeals.
