The Full University Curriculum Committee met on January 20, 2023. Since the last Report to University Council, the committee approved 180 new courses and 572 course changes.

The committee approved the following proposals, which were forwarded to the Executive Committee of the University Council for consideration:

- Proposal to deactivate the Undergraduate Certificate in Disaster Management
- Proposal to deactivate the major in Dance (B.F.A.)
- Proposal for a new minor in Fisheries and Aquatic Sciences
- Proposal for a new minor in Forestry
- Proposal for a new minor in Parks, Recreation, and Tourism Management
- Proposal for a new minor in Wildlife Sciences
- Proposal to offer the existing major in Special Education (M.A.T.) with an Area of Emphasis in General Curriculum online

- Proposal to make the following changes in the College of Agricultural and Environmental Sciences:
 - Proposal to change the name of the major in Animal Science (B.S.A.) to Animal and Dairy Science (B.S.A.)
 - o Proposal to terminate the major in Dairy Science (B.S.A.)
- Proposal for a new major in Animal Biosciences (B.S.A.)

The committee approved a proposal for a new Area of Emphasis in Spanish Interdisciplinary Studies under the major in Spanish (A.B.).

The committee approved a proposal for a new Area of Emphasis in Policy and Sustainability under the major in Forestry and Natural Resources (M.S.).

The committee approved a proposal from the University Curriculum Committee Social Sciences Subcommittee regarding the development of course objectives and learning outcomes. The CAPA system will be updated to include the following statement:

"New course and course change initiators should consult the Center for Teaching and Learning's resources on Student Learning Outcomes before developing course objectives/expected learning outcomes."

The committee considered a proposal for revisions to Policy 4.06-5, Air Force ROTC Commitment and Summer Break, which was approved and forwarded to the UCC by the Educational Affairs Committee. A motion to approve was made and seconded. A vote was taken, and the motion failed. The proposal was returned to the Educational Affairs Committee.
