Back in October, a group of staff attended the USG Staff Council Annual Conference for staff development. The sessions were focused on resiliency in leadership, and it was a great opportunity to network with staff from other USG institutions.

Earlier this month, the Benefits and Classification Committee of the Staff Council was able to host a meeting with the USG Total Rewards Steering Committee. Staff were able to learn about how benefits packages are determined and what data drives these decisions. We look forward to continuing to collaborate with the TRSC.
