Re: Placement of Student Honor Code plaques in instructional classrooms

The Facilities Committee met on March 1, 2006 and approved a proposal from the Office of the Vice President for Instruction to place plaques on which the Student Honor Code is written in every instructional classroom and teaching laboratory on campus. This would not include the School of Law or the College of Veterinary Medicine because those schools have their own honor codes. The proposal was presented by Associate Vice President Ann Crowther and Ms. Debbie Bell. The Office of the Vice President for Instruction is seeking financial support for this project. A mock up of the plaque was shared with members of the facilities committee. It has the arch symbol at the top followed by the phrase "A Culture of Honesty Earns a Degree of Respect." The UGA Honor Code is at the bottom of the plaque; "I will be academically honest in all of my academic work and will not tolerate academic dishonesty of others."
