The Full University Curriculum Committee met on January 19, 2011. Since the last report to University Council, the committee approved 96 new courses and 211 course changes.

The committee approved the following proposals which were forwarded to the Executive Committee of University Council for consideration:

Proposal for a new major in Higher Education (M.Ed.)

Proposal to offer the existing major in Reading Education (M.Ed.) as an external degree online

Proposal to offer a major in Epidemiology (Ph.D.)

Proposal to offer a Graduate Certificate in Latin American and Caribbean Studies

Proposal to terminate the majors in Special Education (Ed.D.) and Mathematics Education (Ed.D.)

Proposal to terminate the Master of Crop and Soil Sciences (M.C.S.S.)

Proposal to terminate the Graduate Certificate in Global Policy Studies

Proposal to deactivate the major in Creative Writing (M.F.A.)

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The committee tabled a request to change the name of the Area of Emphasis in Landscape Management to Landscape Contracting.

The committee approved a proposal for the University of Georgia overlay requirements for the University System of Georgia Core Curriculum.

The committee discussed C- grade reform.

The committee discussed an information item concerned with revising the admission policy for the Terry College of Business.

The committee also discussed the AP Council Report and the procedure for routing of AP Council actions.
