The Executive Committee approved one item forwarded from the Strategic Planning Committee. This appears as the fourth action item on the agenda for today's (Nov. 28) University Council meeting.

The Executive Committee approved as one package 15 minor amendments to the University Council Bylaws forwarded from the Committee on Statutes, Bylaws and Committees. These will have a first reading today as our 5th action item. A 16th proposed amendment concerning the composition of the Curriculum Committee was returned to the Committee on Statutes, Bylaws, and Committees.

In considering New Business, the Committee was informed by the Registrar that next year's Fall Break has been moved from Oct. 25 to Nov. 1 in keeping with the tradition that the break precede directly our annual football contest with the University of Florida. The Committee also was informed that letters regarding elections for the UC 2013-14 term will go out shortly. The Committee approved Catherine White, Pharmacy, to complete the term of Margaret Robinson, now retired. Lastly, the Committee empowered me to identify a faculty member to serve on the Faculty/Staff Parking Appeals Committee, and I would be delighted after we adjourn to hear from any faculty member so interested.
