

- Major accomplishments of SGA since the Spring University Council meeting: medical amnesty policy change on campus; student football ticketing improved; attended several conferences (all USG SGAs, SEC SGAs, national conference of SGA presidents) to learn best ideas and practices from other schools.

-Added polling location on campus: SGA passed through the ACC Board of Elections an early in-person voting location at Tate; voting will take place Nov. 1 and 2, open to any voter registered in Athens-Clarke County; UGAvotes will encourage students, faculty and staff to use this location.

-Other current projects: Expand Open Educational Resources; create additional study space during final exams; improve mental health of students; improve late night transportation.
