Dear Provost Whitten,

The UGA College of Public Health would like to change the name of its Center for Global Health to the Global Health Institute (GHI). The Center was started several years ago with a focus on comparative health systems and has provided a mechanism for students to travel abroad and explore this topic. It also began offering credit courses, which now lead to an undergraduate minor or to an undergraduate and graduate certificate in Global Health. Currently nearly 200 students are either in the minor or a certificate program, and others attend individual courses without joining a program. We currently have three full-time faculty teaching these courses.

Given that at UGA "a center cannot be involved in the independent offering of credit courses or degree programs" we believe the program has outgrown its original status. Moreover, the new director of the program (Dr. Christopher Whalen) plans to further expand the curriculum to include new courses that cover a broader range of topics and eventually to submit a proposal for a new degree program in Global Health to be offered at the undergraduate level. It is an institute that "may be involved in the offering of credit courses and may offer degree programs."

The college has also received a major gift to endow a distinguished professor who will be recruited this year to be based in the program. The gift further endows a fund to support students who conduct international research. We believe that institute status will be more appropriate for accomplishing those goals of our program and our donor.
