The Full University Curriculum Committee met on January 9, 2013. Since the last report to University Council, the committee approved 113 new courses and 394 course changes.

The committee approved the following proposals which have been forwarded to the Executive Committee of the University Council for consideration:

Proposal for a new major in Soil, Water, and Environmental Sciences (M.S., online) in collaboration with other universities

Proposal to change the name of the Department of Educational Psychology and Instructional Technology to the Department of Educational Psychology

Proposal to change the name of the Department of Elementary and Social Studies Education to the Department of Educational Theory and Practice

Proposal for a new Center for Social Justice, Human and Civil Rights

Proposal to reorganize the Fitness Center into a Center for Physical Activity and Health

Proposal for a new Graduate Certificate in African American Studies

Proposal to make the following changes to the A.B. majors offered under the Department of Classics:

Change the name of the major in Latin (A.B.) to Classical Languages (A.B.)

Add the following new Areas of Emphasis under the major in Classical Languages (A.B.):

New Area of Emphasis in Greek

New Area of Emphasis in Latin

New Area of Emphasis in Greek and Latin

Add a new Area of Emphasis in Classical Archaeology under the major in Classical Culture (A.B.)

Terminate the major in Greek (A.B.)

The committee approved a request for a new Area of Emphasis and a change to an existing Area of Emphasis under the major in Educational Psychology (M.A., Ed.S., and Ph.D.):

New Area of Emphasis in Quantitative Methods under the Major in Educational Psychology (Ed.S.)

To: Quantitative Methods

The committee approved the request to create a new prefix, FACS, Family and Consumer Sciences.

The committee approved the request to change the college-wide minimum grade requirement from "C-" to "C" in LAND courses for the Bachelor of Landscape Architecture (B.L.A.) degree.
