SUBJECT: Follow Up: Regents' Test for previously enrolled UGA students

As I requested in my memo dated May 17, 2010, the Educational Affairs Committee of the University Council reviewed the matter of previously enrolled UGA students who lack only the Regents' Test requirement for graduation. The Committee voted to continue the policy that has been in effect. The official University policy, which will appear in the Bulletin, is:

On March 3, 2010, the University of Georgia was approved for an exemption of the Regents' Test by the Board of Regents of the University System of Georgia. As a result, the Regents' Test is not a graduation requirement for students who are enrolled on or matriculated at UGA after March 3, 2010.

Former UGA students who were enrolled at UGA prior to March 3, 2010, and lacked only the Regents' Test requirement for graduation, should contact their dean's office. Deans will consider appeals from such students to be exempted from the Test and certified for graduation on a case-by-case basis.
