- Members introduced themselves, noting departmental roles and areas of interest.

2. Approval of Previous Minutes

3. Announcements & Updates

• New Associate VP for Facilities:

- Clayton Wilcox announced appointment of Mike Gebeke (Illinois State University), starting October 6, 2025.
- o Brings 30 years of facilities leadership experience.

• Organizational Change – Environmental Safety Division:

- Adam Fouche introduced as Interim AVP for Environmental Safety, Risk & Resiliency.
- Consolidation includes Environmental Safety, Office of Emergency Preparedness, Insurance & Claims Management.
- o Potential consideration for ex officio membership on Facilities Committee.

4. Old Business

• Native Plantings Initiative:

- o Collaboration led by Gwynne Darden and Tianna Lucas.
- o Early stage, multiple stakeholders engaged.
- Emphasis on sustainability, beautification, and better communication of existing resources.
- o Next meetings scheduled for October and December 2025.

5. New Business

• Health Sciences Campus & Medical School Update (Darden):

- o \$100M facility (50% UGA / 50% state funds).
- o Construction underway; completion expected Dec 2026.
- o 92,000 sq. ft. facility includes classrooms, simulation and skills labs, anatomy center, biomedical research space.
- o Additional 165 parking spaces planned.
- o Design emphasizes sustainability and outdoor study areas.

• UGA Police Training Annex (Clark):

- o Serves as training HQ and quartermaster facility.
- Staffed weekdays, 8–5; not 24/7.

• Rail Bed / Connectivity Project:

- o Discussion on potential for rails-to-trails or bus rapid transit.
- o Current administrative obstacles with rail crossing removals.
- Seen as long-term connectivity and recreation opportunity.

• Myers Quad and others w/ Basketball Hoops Removal:

- Concern raised by Prof. Lechtreck regarding seasonal removal limiting community use.
- o VP Cook and Chief Clark explained safety and liability concerns tied to past incidents and summer youth camps.
- Committee to revisit issue in Spring 2026 with data review and possible community input.

• Local Emergency Planning Committee (LEPC):

- o Fouche reported Athens-Clarke County has hired a new Emergency Management Coordinator.
- o Efforts underway to revitalize the LEPC with UGA involvement.
