The University Committee on Facilities met shortly after 1pm on 14 January 2022 on Zoom.

The committee considered a resolution presented by Professor Joe Fu to place signs up outside buildings that the Board of Regents, in their November 2021 meeting, determined *not* to rename even though their own subcommittee recommended that 31 buildings at UGA be renamed. After some discussion Ralph Johnson noted that he had spoken with the President's office about the resolution, and was told that the President would veto such a resolution because it would constitute insubordination.

The committee then considered drafting a resolution creating signage inside the buildings that would call attention to the problematic origins of some of the buildings named after prominent supporters of white supremacy. Professor Nelson proposed to communicate with Gwenn Darden to determine the guidelines for indoor signage at the University and bring a resolution to another meeting.
